AN ACT relating to frivolous exceptions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. When exceptions are certified and transmitted 2 to the Chief Justice as frivolous and intended for delay, and 3 are not argued by the excepting party within thirty days 4 thereafter or within such further time as the presiding jus-5 tice shall have allowed therefor, they may be at once over-6 ruled for want of prosecution. .
