

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of the County Commissioners of Franklin County for the repair and permanent improvement of the road from Madrid line through letter E. Plantation and Sandy River Plantation.

Resolved, That the sum of seven hundred and fifty dollars 2 be and is hereby appropriated for the repair and permanent 3 improvement of the road leading from Madrid line through 4 letter E. Plantation and Sandy River Plantation, to the old 5 original highway from Phillips to Rangeley in Franklin 6 County; the same to be drawn by and expended under the 7 direction of the County Commissioners of Franklin County.
