### STATE OF MAINE.

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter eighty-three of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred five, relating to Contagious Diseases among Cattle.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section two of chapter eighty-three of the Pub-2 lic Laws of nineteen hundred five is amended by adding as 3 the last clause thereof the following:

"Except in cases of cattle that have been so tested and 5 certified within twelve months previous to such sale, or 6 calves under four months old."

Sect. 2. Section four of said act is hereby repealed and 2 the following section enacted as section four:

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'Section 4. Whoever violates any provision of the three 4 preceeding sections shall be punished by a fine of not less 5 than twenty-five dollars nor more than fifty dollars for each 6 offense.'
