IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to provide for ice fishing in Great Embden pond, in the town of Embden, in Somerset county.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be lawful to fish for and catch fish

- 2 through the ice, in accordance with the general law of the
- 3 State, on Saturday of each week, during the months of
- 4 February and March of each year, in Great Embden pond,
- 5 so-called, in the town of Embden, in Somerset county.

Sect. 2. So much of section 1 of chapter 407 of the pri-

- 2 vate and special laws of 1903 as is inconsistent with this
- 3 act is hereby repealed.
