STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the City of Portland to provide for the appointment of a Deputy and District Chief of its Fire Department.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. In lieu of four assistant engineers of the fire department of the city of Portland, the City Council of said city may provide by ordinance for the election of one deputy chief engineer and one district chief engineer and said officers, when so elected, shall, together with the chief engineer, constitute, be vested with, and perform all the duties of the board of engineers. In the absence or disability of the chief engineer, all his powers and duties shall devolve upon the deputy chief; and within the district to be prescribed by

10 ordinance, the district chief shall have command, subject to
11 the orders of the chief engineer and the deputy chief en12 gineer. Both the deputy chief engineer and the district chief
13 engineer shall devote their entire time to the department, and
14 shall assist the chief engineer in the discharge of his duties.
