STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, authorizing the Land Agent to release the interest of the State in the Islet called Turnip Island in Bristol in Lincoln County.

Resolved, That the State Land Agent be and he is hereby 2 authorized and empowered upon payment of a nominal con3 sideration to make, execute and deliver a good and sufficient 4 deed releasing to Albert Thorpe, of Bristol, Lincoln County, 5 Maine, and his heirs and assigns all the right, title and inter6 est which the State of Maine has in and to a small Island 7 known as Turnip Island, said Island being situated southeast 8 of Rutherford's Island, together with its adjacent connecting 9 and outlying rocks and reefs to the line of lowest tide on all 10 sides of same, provided that said Thorpe shall first obtain a 11 release from the persons now holding the claim to said Is12 land which Cyrus Jones, late of Bath, held in his life time.
