STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the removal of bodies of deceased persons from an old abandoned cemetery in the town of Lisbon to Lisbon Cemetery, so-called, in said town.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The town of Lisbon is hereby empowered to 2 authorize some suitable person to take up from an old aban-3 doned cemetery on the east side of Ridge road, so-called, in 4 Lisbon Village in the town of Lisbon the bodies and re-5 mains of all deceased persons buried therein and all head-6 stones and markers at the graves therein and remove said 7 bodies and remains to Lisbon Cemetery, so-called, in said 8 town, and there decently inter the same, and properly reset 9 such headstones and markers over such dead bodies and re-10 mains at the expense of said town.
