STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, relating to the purchase of a photograph of General Joshua L. Chamberlain and an oil portrait of Governor Alonzo Garcelon, to be hung in the State House.

Resolved, That the sum of four hundred dollars (\$400.00) 2 be and is hereby appropriated to be expended under and by 3 direction of the Governor and Council, for the purpose of 4 purchasing a colored photograph framed of General Joshua 5 L. Chamberlain, and a framed oil portrait of Governor 6 Alonzo Garcelon, the same to be hung in the State House.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The amount named in the resolve is *first* to allow the Governor and Council to purchase a colored photograph of General Joshua L. Chamberlain, the same to be suitably framed with **a** gold frame. This photograph is 30x40 inches, and is the latest, in fact, the only one ever made of the General in full uniform on horseback, and is considered a remarkably good picture.

Second. To allow the Governor and Council to purchase an oil portrait suitably framed of Governor Alonzo Garcelon.

It is estimated that four hundred dollars is necessary and sufficient for the purchase of both portraits.
