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## STATE OF MAINE.

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IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

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AN ACT to amend Chapter fifty-four of the Public Laws of  
nineteen hundred and seven in relation to the salary of the  
chaplain at the Maine State Prison.

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*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section I. Paragraph twenty-seven, of section one, chap-  
2 ter one hundred and sixteen, of the Revised Statutes, as  
3 amended by chapter fifty-four of the Public Laws of nine-  
4 teen hundred and seven, is hereby further amended by  
5 striking out the words "chaplain, two hundred and fifty  
6 dollars;" also by striking out the words "teacher, three hun-  
7 dred dollars;" and by inserting after the word "guard" in the  
8 twelfth line, the words 'chaplain and teacher, one thousand  
9 dollars.'

Sect. 2. An Act entitled "An Act to amend Section one  
2 of Chapter one hundred and sixteen of the Revised Stat-  
3 utes which provides for a salary of three hundred dollars  
4 for teacher at the Maine State Prison, and two hundred  
5 dollars for chaplain," approved March 12, 1909, is hereby  
6 repealed.
