STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter fifty-four of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and seven in relation to the salary of the chaplain at the Maine State Prison.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Paragraph twenty-seven, of section one, chap2 ter one hundred and sixteen, of the Revised Statutes, as
3 amended by chapter fifty-four of the Public Laws of nine4 teen hundred and seven, is hereby further amended by
5 striking out the words "chaplain, two hundred and fifty
6 dollars;" also by striking out the words "teacher, three hun7 dred dollars;" and by inserting after the word "guard" in the
8 twelfth line, the words 'chaplain and teacher, one thousand
9 dollars.'

Sect. 2. An Act entitled "An Act to amend Section one 2 of Chapter one hundred and sixteen of the Revised Stat-3 utes which provides for a salary of three hundred dollars 4 for teacher at the Maine State Prison, and two hundred 5 dollars for chaplain," approved March 12, 1909, is hereby 6 repealed.
