STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of County Commissioners of Franklin County, for permanent improvements on road in Jerusalem and Crocker Townships.

Resolved, That there be and is hereby appropriated the sum 2 of seven hundred and fifty dollars, to be expended for per-3 manent improvements on road in Jerusalem and Crocker 4 Townships, in Franklin County, between the Kingfield town 5 line and Bigelow; said sum to be expended under the direc-6 tion of the County Commissioners of Franklin County.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The road leading from Kingfield to Eustis, 28 miles, passes through Jerusalem and Crocker Townships. It is the main thoroughfare to the Dead River region. The travel on same is large and constantly increasing. With the exception of ten miles in said plantations State roads have been built which are in excellent condition. This resolve is asked for permanent improvements through said plantations to make the same safe and convenient for public travel. This part of the road at the present time is in dangerous condition.
