RESOLVE, in favor of aiding the building of a bridge in the  
town of Franklin, Hancock County.

---

*Resolved,* That there be and hereby is appropriated the  
2 sum of ten thousand dollars, to aid in the construction of a  
3 bridge across the "Narrows," so-called, in the town of  
4 Franklin; said sum to be paid by the State Treasurer to  
5 the State Highway Commissioner, to be expended under his  
6 direction. Provided however, and on condition that the  
7 towns of Franklin and Sullivan raise a like sum jointly  
8 within two years from the date in which this resolve be-  
9 comes a law.
