STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to authorize the town of Southport to build and maintain a wharf or public landing on the easterly shore of Dog Fish Head, in the town of Southport.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The town of Southport in the county of Lin-2 coln is hereby authorized to build and maintain a public 3 wharf or landing on the easterly shore of Dog Fish Head,

4 so called, in said town of Southport at a point to be located

5 by the selectmen of said town, and to extend said wharf

6 into the tide waters of Ebencook harbor a distance of one

7 hundred and twenty feet from high water mark.

Sect. 2. Said town of Southport is authorized at its next 2 annual town meeting to raise by assessment upon the polls 3 and estates within said town, or by town notes or bonds 4 a sum not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars, to be expended 5 in erecting such wharf or landing, and to raise such sums 6 from year to year as shall be necessary to keep said wharf 7 or landing in repair.
