IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 93, Section 55 of the Revised Statutes of Maine, relating to liens for pressing hay.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Chapter 93, Section 55 of the Revised Statutes 2 is hereby amended by inserting after the third word in the 3 first line of said section the words 'or straw,' and by insert-4 ing after the tenth word in said first line of said section 5 the words 'or straw,' so that said section shall read as 6 follows:

'Sect. 55. Whoever presses hay or straw has a lien on 8 all hay or straw so pressed for the amount due for such 9 pressing, which takes precedence of all other claims except 10 liens reserved to the State and the lien specified in the pre-11 ceding section, continues for thirty days after said pressing 12 is completed and may be enforced by attachment.'
