

RESOLVE, in favor of navigation on Levy, Long and Big Lakes.

Resolved, There be and hereby is appropriated the sum 2 of one hundred and fifty dollars for buoys and replacing 3 buoys to be laid out under the steamboat inspectors direction.



### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

These lakes are full of shoals and are connected by narrows making it difficult to navigate without buoying the channels.
