RESOLVE, in favor of the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of twenty-six thousand dollars for the year nineteen 3 hundred nine, for the support of patients, said sum to be 4 expended under the direction of the Trustees of Insane Hospitals.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

Since the opening of the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital, the income from the patients has never been sufficient to meet expenses, owing to the fact that the board rate of the small number of patients was the same as that of the larger hospital. The average annual difference between expenses and receipts has been twenty-six thousand dollars. This sum has always been supplied by special resolve.
