RESOLVE in favor of the town of Harmony.

Resolved, That the sum of forty-six dollars be and is 2 hereby appropriated to reimburse said town of Harmony 3 for supplies furnished one Archie Mullen and family for 4 the years 1907 and 1908.



STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In the year 1907 Archie Mullen and family came to the town of Harmony, became chargeable and were furnished supplies that year to the amount of eighteen and 74-100 dollars and in 1908 to the amount of twenty-seven and 26-100 dollars.

Mr. Mullen claims to be of foreign birth and that he never has resided in any one town five years in succession. The municipal officers believe, after careful investigation, that these are facts. Therefore he is a ward of the State and not of the town.
