STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend section fifty-one of chapter seventy-nine of the Revised Statutes, relating to the appointment of auditors, surveyors and referees in vacation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Section fifty-one of chapter seventy-nine of 2 the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto 3 the following:

'In all civil cases pending in the supreme judicial court, 5 any justice thereof in vacation may appoint and commission 6 an auditor or surveyor, and upon the written agreement 7 and request of the parties or their attorneys of record such 8 justice may, in vacation, appoint a referee and make any 9 other order or decree, interlocutory or final, in any such

10 case, and the clerk of said court in each county shall enter 11 upon the docket either in term time or vacation, all such 12 appointments and orders in any pending case.'

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act are hereby repealed.
