IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT prohibiting the building of smelt traps in the waters of
Harrington river, Washington County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. That the building of smelt traps in the waters of
2 Harrington river, Washington county, or fishing in any other
3 way in said river for smelts except by using the regular seine
4 or smelt net without wings is unlawful.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this act
2 shall be subject to a penalty of not less than twenty dollars
3 nor more than forty dollars and costs for each offense.
