STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend section fifteen of chapter fifty-four of the Revised Statutes, relating to expenses of the inspector of boilers, engines, etc., of steamboats upon inland waters.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. Section fifteen of chapter fifty-four of the
Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding, after the
word "chapter," in line four of said section, the following
words: 'and the inspector of boilers, engines and their appurtenances shall receive annually, in equal quarterly payments upon the first days of January, April, July and October, in addition to the salary and expenses now allowed by .

8 law, and in lieu of allowance for office-rent and clerk-hire,9 the sum of two hundred dollars.'

Sect. 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of July, 2 one thousand nine hundred nine.
