STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend section one of chapter one hundred and seventy-one of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and seven relating to the State Superintendent of Public Schools.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Section 1. Section one of chapter one hundred and sev-
- 2 enty-one of the Public Laws of nineteen hundred and seven
- 3 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "purpose"
- 4 in line five of said section the words 'he shall employ a clerk,
- 5 who may serve as his deputy, at a salary not to exceed
- 6 fifteen hundred dollars annually, with necessary expenses
- 7 when on official business within the State, and other clerical
- 8 assistance at a cost not to exceed one thousand dollars an-

9 nually,' so that said section, when amended, shall read as to follows:

'Sect. 1. The salary of the State superintendent of schools 12 is hereby established at twenty-five hundred dollars per 13 annum. He shall receive in addition his actual cash expenses 14 incurred in the performance of his official duties, which sum 15 shall be paid out of the specific appropriation for that pur-16 pose. He shall employ a clerk, who may serve as his dep-17 uty, at a salary not to exceed fifteen hundred dollars an-18 nually, with necessary expenses when on official business 10 within the State, and other clerical assistance at a cost not 20 to exceed one thousand dollars annually. He shall perform 21 his official duties at the office provided for him at the seat 22 of government and not elsewhere, not meaning however, 23 to prohibit him from making such necessary journeys and 24 performing such duties as are necessary or incidental to 25 the immediate object of such journey.'

Sect. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this 2 act, are hereby repealed.
