

## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Joseph W. Simpson.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred dollars be and 2 hereby is appropriated to be paid to Joseph W. Simpson 3 for the expenses of the Finance Committee of the last Leg-4 islature in visiting the Home for the Feeble Minded at 5 Waverly, Mass.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

At the last Legislature the appropriation of one hundred dollars was passed for the purpose of the Finance Committee to visit the Home for the Feeble Minded at Waverly, Mass. At the time of the visit the appropriation had not been finally passed upon, so the Chairman of the Committee advanced the money and neglected to collect the same before January 1, 1908, and the law is that all money not paid before that time reverts back to the Treasury.
