IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT creating a lien on Shovel Handle Blocks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Whoever labors in making shovel handle blocks, 2 or cuts or furnishes wood for shovel handle blocks, or is 3 engaged in cooking for such persons engaged in such labor, 4 or furnishes a team for hauling said shovel handle blocks, 5 or the lumber from which they are made has a lien on said 6 shovel handle blocks for the amount due him for his per-7 sonal labor thereon, or the services of his team, and for 8 the amount due for the wood so cut or furnished which 9 takes precedence of all other claims except liens reserved 10 to the State, continues for thirty days after said shovel 11 handle blocks arrive at their destination either for shipment 12 or to be turned, and may be enforced by attachment.
