IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Section 41 of Chapter 66 of the Revised Statutes, relating to the duties of Executors and Administrators.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Section forty-one of chapter sixty-six of the 2 revised statutes is hereby amended by inserting in the first 3 line of said section after the word "deceased" and before 4 the word "was," the words: 'last dwelt in an unorganized 5 township, or.' So that said section as amended shall read 6 as follows:

'Sect. 41. If the deceased last dwelt in an unorganized 8 township, or was not an inhabitant of or resident in the 9 State at the time of his death, public notice shall be given 10 in some newspaper, or in such manner as the judge directs.'
