IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Rumford Falls and Bethel Street Railway.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The time within which the Rumford Falls 2 and Bethel Street Railway, a corporation organized under 3 the general laws of the State, shall actually commence busi-4 ness, is hereby extended two years from the date when this 5 act shall take effect.
