STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT authorizing the construction of a wharf in Casco Bay, Portland.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The Island Ferry Company, a corporation 2 created by and existing under the laws of the State of Maine, 3 its successors and assigns, as the owners or lessees of cer-4 tain land or flats, or riparian rights, on Peaks Island, so 5 called, in the city of Portland, is hereby authorized to con-6 struct and to maintain a private wharf, pier, break-water 7 and ferry-slip, from said island into the tide waters of Casco 8 Bay.

Sect. 2. The location and erection of any wharf, pier,

2 breakwater and ferry-slip already constructed before the 3 approval of this act by the said company, as owner or lessee 4 of said land, flats or riparian rights, and extending from said 5 island into the said tide waters of Casco Bay, are hereby le-6 galized, ratified and confirmed, and the said company, its suc-7 cessors and assigns are hereby authorized to maintain such 8 structure or structures as a private wharf, pier, break-9 water or ferry-slip.
