STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing for an Epidemic or Emergency Fund.

Resolved, That the sum of three thousand dollars annually 2 for two years is hereby appropriated as an epidemic or 3 emergency fund to be used, if necessary, by the State board 4 of health with the consent of the governor and council in 5 case of the invasion or threatened invasion of smallpox or 6 other dangerous epidemic disease into the State, and the 7 governor is hereby authorized to draw his warrant for the 8 same, or such part of the same as may be needed, out of 9 any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.
