IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to extend the charter of the Bethel Trust Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Bethel

Trust Company, located at Bethel, Oxford County, Maine,

which were granted by Chapter sixty of the Private and

Special Laws of nineteen hundred and five and extended for

two years by Chapter thirty-four of the Private and Special

Laws of 1907, are hereby further extended for one year from

the approval of this act; and the persons named in said act,

their associates and successors shall have all the rights and

privileges that were granted them by said act, to be exer
cised in the same manner and for the same purposes as

specified therein; provided, however, that said company shall

actually commence business as a trust company within said

one year.
