STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of Eastern Maine Insane Hospital, to provide for deficiencies.

Whereas, the several deficiency items comprised in this resolve are long overdue, and further delay in the payment thereof will occasion great inconvenience to the management of the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital, and increased expense to the State; and whereas, in the opinion of this Legislature, these facts constitute this resolve an emergency measure, which is immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, now therefore be it

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of thirty-seven thousand four hundred and three dol-3 lars, for the use of the Eastern Maine Insane Hospital, for 4 the following purposes:

For addition and changes to boiler house, necessitated by

6 new buildings recently constructed, for changes in heating 7 system of old buildings, for window guards on one ward 8 of old buildings, and to settle deficit.

Said sum to be appropriated for the year nineteen hun-10 dred and nine, and to be expended under the direction of 11 the Trustees of Insane Hospitals.

In view of the emergency set forth in the preamble, this 13 resolve shall take effect when approved.
