STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Insane Hospital, for kitchen,
bakery and dining-room.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the
2 sum of twenty-eight thousand dollars for the year nineteen
3 hundred and nine, and twenty-eight thousand dollars for
4 the year nineteen hundred and ten, for the use of the Maine
5 Insane Hospital, for the following purposes:

For the renovation of kitchen, bakery, and the erection of
7 a dining-room for employees, finishing and furnishing the
8 same.

Said sums to be expended under the direction of the Trus-
10 tees of Insane Hospitals.
