STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE in favor of the Maine Industrial School for Girls, for water supply and grading.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated to be 2 paid the Maine Industrial School for Girls the sum of two 3 thousand dollars for the year nineteen hundred nine for 4 providing for a suitable water supply; also the sum of five 5 hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred nine and five 6 hundred dollars for the year nineteen hundred ten for grad-7 ing and draining the grounds and the construction of road-8 ways.

STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The water supply of the institution is limited and uncertain. In times of drought a water famine impends and the school has to be put on a short allowance of water. This has been done the past season. The sum asked for is to provide a sure supply.

The sums asked for grading and draining and construction of roads are to complete the work of grading the grounds, finishing a roadway now partially built and surfacing the service yards.
