STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to confirm the organization of the Bangor Young Men's Christian Association, of Bangor, Maine, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
Section I. The Bangor Young Men's Christian Associa2 tion, of Bangor, Maine, is declared to be a corporation duly
3 organized under Chapter 57 (formerly 55) of the Revised
4 Statutes of Maine, for the purposes as set forth in its arti5 cles of association and its constitution, and as such is en6 titled to the privileges and subject to the obligations of such
7 corporations.

Sect. 2. Said corporation may take and hold by purchase, 2 gift, devise or bequest, personal or real estate heretofore 3 or hereafter acquired to any amount, and may use and dis-4 pose thereof only for the purposes aforesaid.
