STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of the town of Mount Chase in Penobscot County.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the sum 2 of one hundred and fifty dollars to aid in repairing two miles 3 of road and a bridge constituting a part thereof, said two 4 miles of road to be the first two miles east of the west line 5 of the town of Mount Chase to the town of Patten; the same 6 to be expended by the Highway Commissioner of the town 7 of Mount Chase, under the direction of an agent to be ap-8 pointed for that purpose by the Governor and Council.
