AN ACT to extend the charter of the Wells Electric Light and Power Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. The rights, powers and privileges of the Wells

- 2 Electric Light and Power Company, which were granted by
- 3 chapter three hundred and five of the Private and Special
- 4 Laws of nineteen hundred and seven, are hereby extended
- 5 for two years from the passage of this act; and the per-
- 6 sons named in said act, their associates and successors, shall
- 7 have all the rights, powers and privileges that were granted
- 8 them by said act, to be exercised in the same manner and
- 9 for the same purposes as specified in said act.
