STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter four hundred and fifty-five of the Private and Special Laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven and to permit Good Will Home Association to increase its capital.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section one of chapter four hundred and fifty-2 five of the Private and Special Laws of the year one thou-3 sand eight hundred and ninety seven is hereby amended by 4 striking out the word "five" in the sixth line thereof and 5 inserting the word "twelve" in place thereof, so that said 6 section shall read as follows:

'Section I. The Good Will Home Association, a charit-8 able corporation formed under the provisions of chapter

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9 fifty-five of the Revised Statutes for the purpose of aiding 10 needy boys, and located at East Fairfield in Somerset County, 11 is hereby authorized to take and hold by purchase, gift, de-12 vise, or bequest, personal or real estate, in all not exceeding 13 twelve hundred thousand dollars owned at any one time.' •
