

STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of investigation of industrial education.

Resolved, That the sum of one thousand dollars be and 2 hereby is appropriated for the year nineteen hundred nine 3 and a like sum for the year nineteen hundred ten to be ex4 pended under the direction of the State Superintendent of 5 Public Schools for the purpose of making a special inves6 tigation of the needs of the State in relation to a system of 7 vocational or industrial education, together with an inves8 tigation into the methods adopted by other states and coun9 tries for meeting similar needs. Said superintendent in his 10 regular report shall incorporate a report of the work done 11 under this resolve, with such recommendation as he may 12 make.
