## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Section 25 of Chapter 129 of the Revised Statutes relating to the sale of cigarettes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section 25 of Chapter 129 of the Revised 2 Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word 3 "year" in the third line thereof the words 'or purchase for 4 or at the solicitation of any person under the age of twenty-5 one years,' so that said section as amended shall read as 6 follows:

'Sect. 25. Whoever, by himself, his clerk, servant, or 8 agent, directly or indirectly sells, offers for sale, or has 9 in his possession with intent to sell, or gives away, to any 10 person under the age of twenty-one years, or purchases for

11 or at the solicitation of any person under the age of twenty12 one years, any cigarette, shall be punished by fine not ex13 ceeding fifty dollars or by imprisonment not exceeding sixty
14 days. Trial justices and municipal and police courts shall
15 have jurisdiction of offenses arising under this section.'
