## STATE OF MAINE.

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend section nineteen of chapter thirty of the Revised Statutes relating to the sale of poisons.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section I. Section nineteen of chapter thirty of the Re-2 vised Statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the 3 word "apothecary" in the first line thereof, the words 'upon 4 the written prescription of a physician.' So that said sec-5 tion as amended shall read as follows: 'No person except 6 a registered apothecary upon the written prescription of a 7 physician, or a physician in regular standing in his pro-8 fession, shall furnish, sell or keep for sale any opium, mor-9 phine or laudanum. Whoever violates this section shall be 10 punished by a fine of not less than five, or more than fifty 11 dollars, to be recovered by complaint or indictment.' •
