IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT creating a lien on Shovel Handle Blocks.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Whoever labors in making shovel handle  
2 blocks, or cuts or furnishes wood for shovel handle blocks,  
3 or is engaged in cooking for such persons engaged in such  
4 labor, or furnishes a team for hauling said shovel handle  
5 blocks, or the lumber from which they are made has a lien  
6 on said shovel handle blocks for the amount due him for  
7 his personal labor thereon, or the services of his team, and  
8 for the amount due for the wood so cut or furnished which  
9 takes precedence of all other claims except liens reserved to

10 the State, continues for thirty days after said shovel handle  
11 blocks arrive at their destination either for shipment or to  
12 be turned, and may be enforced by attachment.
