STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend An Act entitled "An Act to create a lien on
manufactured Staves and Laths."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter twenty-five of the Private and Special
2 Laws of nineteen hundred and seven is hereby amended by
3 inserting in the first line thereof after the word "of," the
4 word 'shingle,' and in the second line after the word "of,"
5 the word 'shingle,' and in the third line after the word
6 "into," the word 'shingles,' and in the fourth line after the
7 word "such," the words 'shingles or,' and in the eighth line
8 after the word "timber," the word 'shingles,' so that said
9 section when amended shall read as follows:

‘Section 2. Whoever labors at cutting, hauling or sawing
11 of shingle, stave, lath, or dowel timber or in the manufac-
12 ture of shingle, stave, lath or dowel timber into shingles,
13 staves, laths, or dowels and the piling of such staves or laths
14 and the bunching of such shingles or dowels or at cooking
15 for persons engaged in such labor has a lien thereon for the
16 amount due for his personal services and the services per-
17 formed by his team, which takes precedence of all other
18 claims, continues for sixty days after such timber, shingles,
19 staves, laths and dowels are manufactured provided the
20 same have not been sold and shipped.’
