AN ACT to confirm the title of Ram Island in Hancock
County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of confirming the title of
2 Charles H. Welch to Ram Island, so called, situated near
3 Gott's Island, in Hancock County, the State Land Agent
4 is authorized to make, execute and deliver to him a deed
5 conveying all the interest of the State therein.
