IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE  
HUNDRED AND NINE.

---

AN ACT additional to chapter one hundred twenty-eight of the  
Revised Statutes relating to malicious mischiefs and tres-  
passes.

---

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

Section 1. Whoever unlawfully and intentionally injures,  
2 molests or destroys any insulator, wire, post, cross-arm,  
3 bracket, or other structure or mechanism which forms part  
4 of, or is used in connection with an electrical transmission  
5 line constructed and maintained for the transmission of in-  
6 telligence, heat, light or power by electricity or destroys or  
7 in any way interferes with the proper working of such trans-  
8 mission line, or anything pertaining thereto, shall be pun-

9 ished by a fine of not more than one hundred dollars or by  
10 imprisonment for not more than one year, or by both such  
11 fine and imprisonment.
