IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend section thirteen of chapter four of the
Revised Statutes, relating to choice of Road Commissioner
in Towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Section thirteen of chapter four of the revised
2 statutes is hereby amended by inserting after the word
3 "elect" in the first line thereof the words 'and all towns
4 with over sixty-five hundred inhabitants shall elect,' so that
5 said section as amended shall read as follows:

'Sect. 13. Each town at its annual meeting may elect and
7 all towns with over sixty-five hundred inhabitants shall
8 elect by major vote a road commissioner, who shall hold
9 his office for the term of one year from the date of his

10 election. Any town may, at its option, elect not more than
11 three commissioners, whose powers and duties shall be the
12 same as prescribed for a single commissioner. No person
13 shall, at the same time, hold the office of road commissioner
14 and selectman.'
