STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate ice fishing in Pattie's pond, in Winslow,
in Kennebec County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to fish for,
2 take, catch or kill any kind of fish through the ice in Pattie's
3 pond, so-called, in Winslow, in the county of Kennebec, ex-
4 cept on Tuesday and Saturday of each week, on which days
5 it shall be lawful to fish in said pond in accordance with the
6 general law of the State. Whoever violates any of the pro-
7 visions of this section shall be subject to the same penalty as
8 is provided in the general law of the State for the illegal
9 fishing for and catching trout and landlocked salmon.

Sect. 2. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal and
2 police courts and trial justices within their respective coun-
3 ties, shall have, upon complaint, original and concurrent
4 jurisdiction with the supreme and superior courts, and all
5 fines, forfeitures and penalties received for violation of this
6 act shall be paid forthwith by the person receiving the same
7 to the State Treasurer, and credited to fines and license fees
8 for the protection of birds and game.
