STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to regulate fishing in Little Big Wood Pond, Somerset
County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to fish for, take, catch or
2 kill any kind of fish in Little Big Wood pond, so called, in
3 Somerset County, through the ice, for a period of five years
4 from the time this act takes effect.

Sect. 2. Whoever violates any of the provisions of this
2 act shall be subject to the same penalty as is provided in the
3 general law of the State for illegal fishing.

Sect. 3. In all prosecutions under this act, municipal and
2 police courts and trial justices in their respective counties
3 shall have upon complaint original and concurrent jurisdic-
4 tion with the supreme judicial and superior courts, and all

5 fines, forfeitures and penalties received for violation of this
6 act shall be paid forthwith by the person receiving the same
7 to the State Treasurer, and credited to fines and license fees
8 for the protection of birds and game.
