STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE
HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend Chapter 166 of the Public Laws of 1907,
Entitled "An Act for the Better Collection of Taxes."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 166 of the public laws of 1907 is here-
2 by amended, so that said act shall read as follows: "Municipi-
3 pal officers of cities and towns in making out their yearly
4 reports shall cause to be printed in said reports the names
5 of all delinquent tax payers and the amounts of their unpaid
6 taxes which have been committed to the treasurer or col-
7 lector for collection. For any violation of this duty such
8 municipal officers shall forfeit not less than five nor more
9 than twenty-five dollars to be recovered on complaint."
