

## STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE providing for deficiency in appropriation for expenses of Australian ballot for the year nineteen hundred eight.

Resolved, That there be and hereby is appropriated the 2 sum of six hundred dollars on account of deficiency in 3 appropriation for expenses of Australian ballot for the year 4 nineteen hundred eight.



#### STATEMENT OF FACTS.

The appropriation for expenses of Australian ballot for the year 1908 did not take into account the fact that a presidential election was to be held in that year, and the amount appropriated was the same as for the year 1906, when a State election only occurred. The amount called for in this resolve is for the payment of bills of newspapers of the State for publishing the list of nominations for electors, as required by law.
