STATE OF MAINE.

RESOLVE, in favor of the town of Frenchville for one hundred forty-one dollars and seventy-five cents to be paid to the town of Frenchville on account of State road constructed in nineteen hundred and eight.

Resolved, That the sum of one hundred forty-one dollars

- 2 and seventy-five cents be and hereby is appropriated to reim-
- 3 burse the town of Frenchville on account of State road con-
- 4 structed in the year nineteen hundred and eight-

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STATEMENT OF FACTS.

In the year 1908 the town of Frenchville, Aroostook County, 2 constructed a section of State road 2800 feet long, 25 feet in width and for the drainage of this road built 8 culverts of cedar; the dimensions of each of the culverts being 12"x36"x20'. The total cost of the construction was \$236.25.

The State highway department refused the payment of aid on the ground that the work was not built according to specification.

The town seeks reimbursement as this was its first attempt at the construction of State road and the municipal officers were not fully aware of just what was expected and feel that the withholding of aid at the present time will discourage the town from making future appropriations and doing any more work on the State road.
