IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT relative to school outhouses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows: Section 1. It shall be the duty of the superintending school
committee to provide at least two suitable and convenient
outhouses or water closets for each school building. Said
outhouses or water closets shall have separate means of access. The superintending school committee shall have said
outhouses and water closets kept in a clean and suitable condition. Towns shall appropriate a sum of money sufficient
to enable said superintending school committee to comply
with the provisions of this act.
