## STATE OF MAINE.

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND NINE.

AN ACT to amend chapter eighty-eight of the Public Laws of 1907, entitled "An Act to encourage the compiling and teaching of local history and local geography in the public schools."

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Section 1. Chapter eighty-eight of the Public Laws of 2 1907 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following 3 sections:

'Sect. 6. The State historian is authorized to expend, 5 under the direction of the governor and council, any por-6 tion of the amount appropriated by this act, in the publi7 cation of historical matter and data relating to the history 8 of Maine.'

'Sect. 7. The marking of historical sites, as authorized to by the legislature, shall be under the direction of the State 11 historian.'
